General Membership Policy

POLICY:

All sponsored activities such as workshops, 10-hour stitch-ins, retreats, and Spring Festival will have a fee set for members of the Embroiderers' Guild of Victoria (EGV). Non-members will pay an additional, minimum premium of \$10.00 or 25% of the total cost of the activity – whichever is the greater – for each activity they choose to attend. Members will have the opportunity to register for workshops and guild activities prior to the opening of registration to non-members.

All EGV members must abide by the regulations of the Societies Act of BC.

Membership renewals will be on an annual basis with the renewal date of August 1. Monies for membership should be received by June 30, for continuing members, to ensure the membership renewal is processed before the August 1 deadline.

New members joining during the year will have their fees prorated to ensure all members have an August 1 renewal date.

REVIEW:

Amendments to this policy may be proposed by the executive and/or an appointed Policy Review Committee and adopted after being discussed and voted upon by the general membership.
